

Portion of the 1852 map for the US Navy. Shows what we call "Ryer Island" now as Sutter Island. Shows Grand Island as Tyler Island. The infamous "hogsback" often spoken of in navigation books and ships logs of the day make it appear hogsback was located where Snug Harbor is now, and not where the current "Hogback Park" is located!

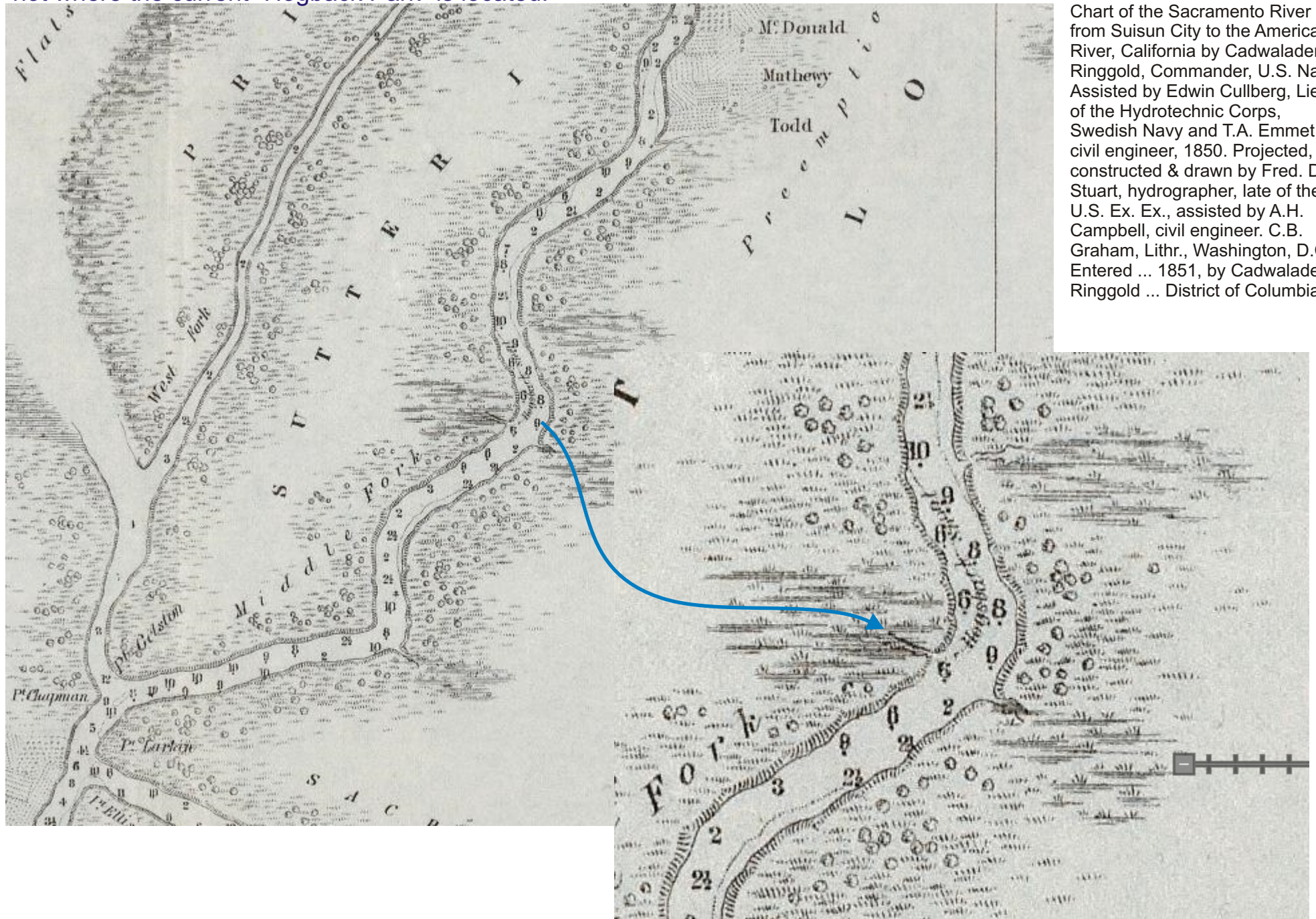
